

Public hearing and comment period:

Kansas City Power & Light Company's Request for Increase

Kansas City Power & Light Company has filed an application with the Kansas Corporation Commission (Commission) to request permission to modify its tariffs to continue implementation of its regulatory plan.

Public Hearing

The Commission has scheduled a public hearing concerning the rate increase that Kansas City Power and Light Company (KCP&L) has requested. This hearing will allow the KCP&L customers to learn more about the proposed rate increase and provide an opportunity for customers to present testimony or comments for the Commission's review. The public hearing will take place in two parts. First, a question and answer period will allow customers to ask Kansas City Power & Light Company representatives, the Commission staff and a representative from CURB questions pertaining to the increase.

In the second part of the hearing, customers will be allowed to make formal statements to the three-member Commission.

The public hearing has been scheduled Wednesday, April 28, 2010 from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

The Commission will accept written comments from KCP&L's customers through July 30, 2010. The KCC has until November 22, 2010 to make a decision on the proposed increase.

Kansas City Power & Light Company's Requested Increase

On December 17, 2009, Kansas City Power & Light Company filed an application to make changes to its charges for electric service. KCP&L is asking for a \$55.2 million increase and if granted will be approximately 11.5% increase on consumer bills. This is KCP&L's fourth and final case in the regulatory plan approved in 2004 (1025 Docket). The application does request

pursuant to agreement amongst the parties that there will be a fifth abbreviated case to true-up the budgeted cost to actual cost incurred in the Iatan 2 construction project.
