

## **Public hearing and comment period:**

### **KCP&L'S Proposed Demand-Side-Management Programs and Cost Recovery:**

Kansas City Power and Light Company (KCP&L) has filed an application with the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) seeking approval to implement a portfolio of demand-side-management programs and to implement a rider for recovery of program costs and to recover incentives associated with this portfolio from customers. KCP&L estimates that the average residential customer will pay an additional \$3.54 per month to cover the costs of these proposals.

#### **Public Hearing**

The Commission has scheduled a public hearing concerning the proposal that KCP&L has requested. This hearing will allow the KCP&L customers to learn more about the proposal and provide an opportunity for customers to present testimony or comments for the Commission's review.

The public hearing will take place in two parts. First, during the question and answer period, representatives of KCP&L, the KCC staff, and CURB will be available to answer customers' questions pertaining to the proposed increase. In the second part of the hearing, customers will be allowed to make formal statements to the three-member Commission.

The KCC has scheduled a public hearing regarding KCP&L's proposal:

The Commission will accept written comments from KCP&L Company's customers through November 19, 2010. ## **KCP&L seeks approval for Demand-Side-Management Programs (DSM) and Cost Recovery:**

On June 11, 2010, KCP&L Company filed an application seeking approval to implement a portfolio of Demand-Side-Management Programs and to implement a rider for recovery of program costs and to recover incentives associated with this portfolio from customers. KCP&L estimates over a five-year period customers would be charged an average of \$0.00308 per kilowatt hour (kWh). As a result, for the average residential customer, KCPL estimates that \$3.54 would be added to the customer bill each month for the costs of these proposals.
