

LOW INCOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIEAP) ENROLLMENT PERIOD JANUARY 3, 2023 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2023

Assistance with energy bills is available in Kansas for low-income households that meet certain qualifications. The Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP) is a Federally-funded program that helps eligible households pay a portion of their home energy costs by providing a one-time per year benefit. Applications are made through the Kansas Department of Children and Families.

The 2023 application period is January 3, 2023 through Friday March 31, 2023, prior to 5:00 p.m. Here are the basic eligibility provisions for qualifying for assistance:

1. An adult living at the address must be personally responsible for paying the heating costs incurred at the current residence, payable either to the landlord or the fuel vendor.
2. Applicants must demonstrate a recent history of payments toward purchase of the primary heating energy.
3. The household must qualify under the following income guidelines:

The combined gross income (before deductions) of all persons living at the address may not exceed 150% of the federal poverty level according to the guidelines listed below:
